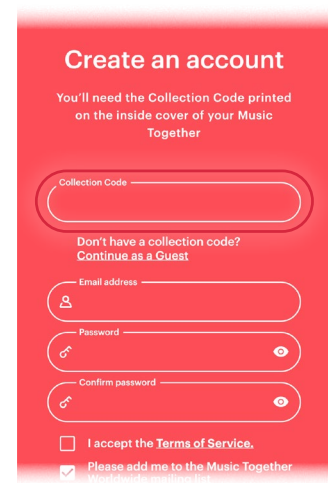
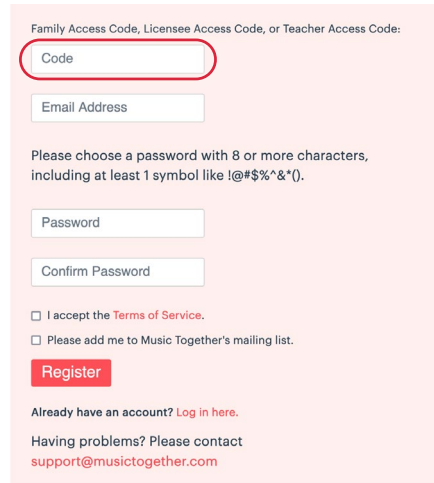
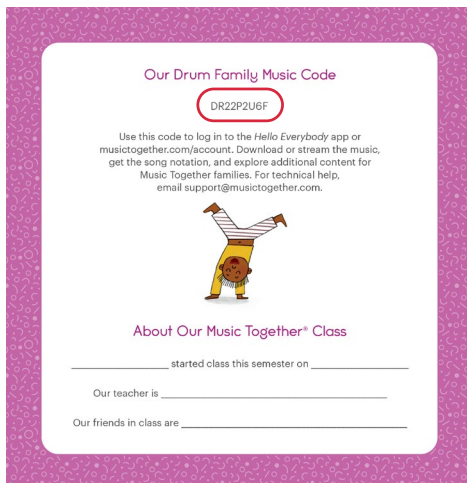
Playing Your Music Together® Songs at Home

Each semester, your family will receive a new collection of songs to sing, dance, and jam along to. You can access the digital version of your songs in two ways, using the Family Access Code on the inside cover of your songbook or download card.

- 1 Download mp3s or stream songs from the **Family Music Zone**, musictogether.com/familymusiczone
- 2 Play songs through the **Music Together® app**, available for Apple and Android devices

Create a MusicTogether.com Account

First, you'll create a Music Together account, either through the Music Together app or at musictogether.com/account. The process is the same: you'll enter the code that's printed on the inside cover of your songbook or download card, along with your email address and a password of your choice.



Note: This account is separate from any that you use to register for class/makeups at your local center. There is no financial or personal information stored in your MusicTogether.com account.

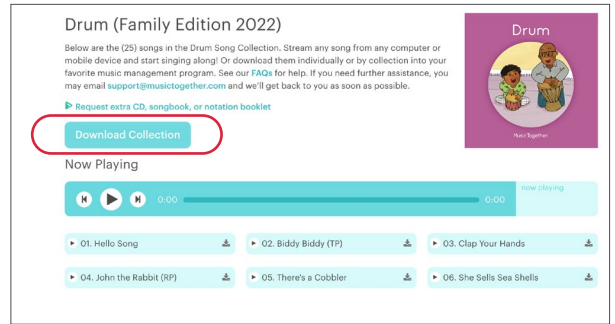
Share the Music with All Your Child's Caregivers

You can use the same account credentials to log in to both the Family Music Zone and the Music Together app, with no limit on the number of devices. So, feel free to share your account login with extended family and/or caregivers, so everyone can share in the musical fun.



Playing Music on iTunes®/Apple Devices

To play your Music Together songs through iTunes® and add them to your own playlists, etc., you will need to download the mp3s to your computer from the Family Music Zone®, and import them to iTunes. They'll then be added to your music Library on your Apple devices. Playing Music on a Smart Speaker, Music App, or Children's Music Player

Use the Family Music Zone® to download mp3s to sync up with your favorite music apps (e.g., Spotify®), smart speakers (e.g., Alexa), or your child's music player (e.g., Tonies®). Follow the manufacturer's instructions on adding mp3s to the particular device. Here are some helpful links.
